


2024 GUERNSEY COUNTY JUNIOR FAIR BOARD APPLICATION

2024 GUERNSEY COUNTY JUNIOR FAIR BOARD REQUIREMENTS & DATES



- The Guernsey County Junior Fair Board Member will abide by all by-laws of the Guernsey County Junior Fair Board
- The Guernsey County Junior Fair Board is a group of youth representing Guernsey County. They will assist the Guernsey County Senior Fair Board and its affiliates with any and all assistance need (i.e. fairground work days, Senior Fair Board events, assistance at livestock shows, camps, etc.).
- The Guernsey County Junior Fair Board hosts several events during the Guernsey County Fair (i.e. Junior Fair Night, Barnyard Throwdown and Supreme Showman Contest). Each member is required to attend each even hosted by The Guernsey County Junior Fair Board.
- The Guernsey County Junior Fair Board is a group of youth that mentor other youth and sportsmanship is a must!

GUERNSEY COUNTY JR. FAIRBOARD BY-LAWS

- Article I. The name of the organization shall be Guernsey County Junior Fairboard (the "Organization"). Organized in the County of Guernsey County, Ohio.
- Article II. Meetings will be set by advisors and will begin in February through January. The annual achievement and awards program will be held in October.
- Article III. Advisors and members are required by the Organization to attend six (6) Organization meetings. If members are not able to attend, members are required to notify the main advisor by means of communication that is predetermined by the member (i.e., email, text, remind, etc).
- Article IV. All advisors and members must attend one (1) meeting prior to April 1st (the County deadline for 4-H enrollment). Any members not in attendance to one (1) meeting prior to April 1st will not be able to be a member of Guernsey County Junior Fairboard.
- Article V. The Organization uses basic principles of parliamentary procedures as defined in Roberts Rule of Order.
- Article VI. The simple majority of "votes in favor" will pass decision.
- Article VII. Officers will be elected by majority vote at the third meeting of each year.
- Article VIII. All officers must be a Guernsey County Junior Fairboard member for one year prior to election.
- Article IX. The president, vice president, secretary and treasurer can only miss three (3) non-approved meetings a year. If more than three are missed, said officer will be asked to step down and the Organization will vote on vacancies in any given office.
- Article X. Committees for any special purpose will be appointed by president and voted by the Organization at any time.
- Article XI. Organized committees (i.e., Supreme Showmanship, Barnyard Throwdown, etc.) will be chosen by members by the third (3) meeting of each year.
- Article XII. Advisors have the right to dismiss members from a meeting due to behavior problems.
- Article XIII. No smoking, swearing, alcohol, tobaccos products or fighting is allowed at meetings. Advisors have the right to dismiss members from a meeting if in violation of this article.
- Article XIV. Anyone caught violating any Junior Fair Rules in a Junior Fair Event will be expelled from the Organization and will be reported.
- Article XV. Organization members will work with Guernsey County Senior Fairboard in all activities that they request the Organization to participate.

- Article XVI. Members will be required to complete an application each year to remain on the Organization.
- Article XVII. Members are required to be affiliated with a Guernsey County Youth Program (i.e., Guernsey County 4-H, Guernsey County FFA (Buckeye Trail, Meadowbrooke, Cambridge), Boy Scouts, Girls Scouts or FCCLA).
- Article XVIII. All rules and regulations imposed by the Guernsey County Animal Committees and Miscellaneous Committees shall remain in full force and Effect.
- Article XIX. All rules and regulations imposed by the Guernsey County Senior Fairboard and affiliated organizations (i.e., Ohio State Extension (4-H), FFA, Boy Scouts, Girls Scouts or FCCLA) shall remain in full force and effect.
- Article XX. Membership will be from February 2023 through January 2024 with our financial year ending October 2023.
